\$130,613*

This funding will be used to

- Support the quality teaching of Reading to ensure that every student achieves at or above National Minimum Standards (NMS) in Year 3 and Year 5, or are working on an Individual Support Plan.
- Increase the number of students achieving at or above a C standard in English and Mathematics to above 75%.
- Provide speech language intervention to ensure eligible students are identified for speech support.
- Support the implementation of Positive Behaviour for Learning to improve student engagement.

Our initiatives include

- Providing focused and intensive teaching of reading using Daily Rapid Reading and Reading Links either individually or in small groups in order to assist students in reaching a C standard in English & Mathematics.
- Identifying and providing speech language support for students.
- Implementing a whole school approach to improving student engagement using regional support in Positive Behaviour for Learning.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Engaging teacher aides in Prep to year 3 classes to implement Daily Rapid Reading and Reading Links \$100,000.
- Provision of additional teacher aide support for speech language needs \$25,000.
- Provision of release time & resources for teaching staff to implement Positive Behaviour for Learning across the school \$5,000.
